## Orange County Association of School Administrators (OCASA) Legislative Platform 2017-2018

- 1. Change the State Testing and Accountability Systems.
  - \* Revise the state **accountability system** using balanced measures. If **learning gains** are used, make calculations equitable.
  - \*Avoid changing **measures** annually to provide data that can be compared annually.
  - \*Eliminate **school grades**. This practice has run its course and results have plateaued. The labeling of a school with either a letter or number should not be permitted. Negatively impacting a school and a community with a low grade is to be avoided.
  - \*Reduce the amount of **testing**. Imbalanced testing has created a nine month school year.
  - \*Reduce mandatory **retention**. More aggressive instructional interventions are needed to minimize retaining young children.
- 2. Make Adjustments to the Implementation of the Class Size Amendment.
  - \*Add flexibility by using **school averages** where applicable. Having to add a teacher when a class grows over the limit is expensive and challenging.
- 3. Eliminate Legislation of Teacher Evaluation and Merit Pay.
  - \*Rescind legislation related to **evaluation systems**. This repeal will provide autonomy for **districts** to design and implement their own evaluation system.
  - \*Eliminate **merit pay** as it appears to not have had an impact on student achievement.
